East Wing consists of 43 units that open onto an extensive garden area and have a combined bed - lounge room area with an ensuite bathroom. The other 15 units are located in Allworth Wing. This wing is a secure unit and is designated for Dementia and High care residents. “Len’s Lodge” is a fully renovated couples House situated in Whiteley Street directly across from the East Wing.

Maranatha House offers a vast range of activities and has regular bus trips and outings, entertainers, happy hour are all suggested by our residents and organised by our Emotional and Spiritual support workers.

Maranatha has a Hairdresser who visits twice a week, Hearing Clinic,

visiting Doctor, Physiotherapist and referral network to any medical services as required.



Maranatha House is a low-high care aged care facility that offers ageing in place. This means that residents are not taken from the environment they are familiar with or away from the people who have cared for them.
